



North Lake Men's Golf

North Lake Presbyterian Church has a men's golf league that is open to members and non-members of the church. (Updated July, 2017)

Here is a summary of how we play:

- We play the 3rd Monday of the month
- The current course is Eagle Ridge (Any change will be communicated)
- AM tee times in Summer and possibly later in the AM in other seasons
- We have league rules to facilitate pace of play (Separate document)
- Players input \$2 for 1st to 3rd or 4th place winners and \$1 for Par 3 closest to the pin (number of Par 3's and winners depends on number of players)
- Prize money (minus \$3 per month for RSVP web services) is distributed roughly as a 40/30/15/15 split with rounding to whole dollars to =100%
- Play is normally from the Senior tees; arrangements can be made for exceptions
- Scoring is based on modified Stableford (Bogie=1; Par=2; Birdie=3; Eagle/Hole-in-One=4) and individual quotas based on past performance (type of handicap)
- New players without official handicap will establish an initial quota on first round and will NOT participate in prize money this first round
- Quotas are then adjusted based on average points for up to the last 5 games
- Registration to play is through our invitation system only

To obtain invitation and register to play:

- Download and read Rules of Play and RSVP Instructions
- Send an email to Glenn Dennison at glennRme@gmail.com
- Include your full name and phone # and GHIN if you have one
- You will be sent an email with additional information concerning league play
- You will be sent an email invitation to play a couple weeks before the next event
- The invitation will have a link to a website where you will confirm YES or NO to play, include a message to Glenn if needed, and add a guest if desired
- A few days (5 or 6) before the event you will be sent an email showing your group and tee time (If you have a preferred group you will be placed with them)
- Arrive at the course with enough time to: pay your greens fees, check in with the organizers, go to the driving range or practice putt, and tee off on time
- After the round, ensure someone with your group turns in a scorecard to the organizers
- Winners will receive awards after all players have finished or at next event if you are not able to wait
- You will receive an email a few days after each event with results of play
