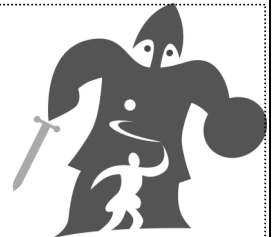
**Warriors, Troops, and the Lord of Hosts**

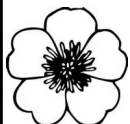
### **2 Timothy 2:3-4 (NRSV)**
