Everyone is interested in the future. James warns us about common mistakes we make regarding our future.

13 Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." **14** Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. **15** Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." **16** As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. **17** So then, if you know the good you ought to do and don't do it, you sin.

James 4:13-17

3 COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

MISTAKE #1: Planning without God

"Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business, and make money.' " (vs. 13)

THE SOLUTION: Include God in your Plan

"Instead, you ought to say, 'IF it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.' " (vs. 15)

"We may make our plans, but God has the last word, "
(Proverbs. 16: 1 Good News)

"We should make plans -- counting on God to direct us. " (Proverbs. 16:9 Living Bible)

THE SOLUTION: Live One Day at a Time

"So don't be anxious about tomorrow - God will take care of your tomorrow, too. Live one day at a time." (Matthew 6:34 Living Bible)

MISTAKE #3: Procrastination

"Anyone then, who knows the good he ought to do and doesn't do it sins. " (vs. 17)

THE SOLUTION: Do It Now.

"Do not withhold good from those who deserve it, when it is in your power to act. Do not say to your neighbor, 'Come back later; I'll give it tomorrow, ... when you now have it with YOU."
